Third circular and on-line registration

Dear colleagues and friends,

This is the third circular concerning The 15th International Saga Conference 2012 at Aarhus University. First of all, we wish to thank warmly for the many inspiring paper and poster proposals that we have received. Acceptances were e-mailed the 20th of December 2011. We are overwhelmed by the amount of proposals, and we are planning for six parallel sessions throughout the conference week.

In this third circular we wish to give you some details about registration, accommodation and the Pre-Print Publications. We also wish to direct your attention to the conference website www.sagaconference.au.dk. The website is continuously updated, and we hope that it will provide answers to many of the questions that you may have.

On-line registration

On-line registration is possible from the 1st of February 2012 to the 1st of June 2012. If you register after the 1st of May there is an increased fee. When you wish to register, please go to the conference website and click the registration link guiding you to the on-line form. Payment has to be done when you register. In earlier circulars we announced that registration is possible until the $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ of July. For practical reasons we have had to change this date, which means that registration is possible until the $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ of June 2012, and not the $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ of July as stated earlier. We apologize for the inconvenience this may cause you.

Deadline for final registration is the 1st of June 2012.



Accommodations

KongresKompagniet has made preliminary hotel reservations for the delegates in the following three hotels, which are Scandic Hotel Plaza, Hotel Atlantic and Hotel Cab Inn. If you wish to stay in one of these hotels, your reservation is to be made by using the on-line registration form. The hotels will be booked on a first-come, first-served basis. Payment is to be made directly to the hotel upon departure.

Scandic Hotel Plaza **** The Scandic Plaza Aarhus is located in the heart of the city, and very close to the Main Railway Station. The walking distance to the university is about 25 minutes. The room prices are per night from DKK 1050 for a single room. See further details about room prices in the on-line registration form.

<u>Hotel Atlantic</u> *** The Comfort Hotel Atlantic is located in the city centre. The walking distance to the university is about 25 minutes. Room prices per night are from DKK 1025 for a single room. See further details about room prices in the on-line registration form.

Hotel Cab Inn ** The Hotel Cab Inn is located in the heart of the city. The walking distance to the university is about 20 minutes. Room prices per night are from DKK 545 for a single room. See further details about room prices in the on-line registration form.

Abstracts for papers must not exceed 2 pages (800 words). Abstracts for posters must not exceed 5 pages (2000 words). Be aware of the limit, as we do not accept texts that exceed the allowed number of words.
