Call for papers and posters - CLOSED

It is with great pleasure that we now open the Call for papers and posters for the 15th International Saga Conference 2012.

If you are planning to give a paper or to present a poster at the Conference, your abstract of the proposed paper or proposed poster has to be submitted no later than the 1st of November 2011 (abstracts received later than the 1st of November may not be considered). *The deadline is postponed to the 8th of November*

The abstracts should be e-mailed to sagaconference@hum.au.dk Acceptances will be e-mailed no later than the 1st of February 2012.

When you submit your abstract, kindly, indicate in your e-mail if you wish to give a paper (30 minutes, up to 20 minutes for the presentation and 10 minutes for discussion) or a poster (the dimensions of the poster board are 150 cm wide x 120 cm high; poster presentations are scheduled for Thursday afternoon).

The abstracts of proposed papers and proposed posters should be a maximum of 250 words, and preferably to be submitted in word-format.

If you propose a paper also indicate in your e-mail in which of the following sessions you wish your paper to be included: Memory and Fiction; Textuality and Manuscript Transmission; Oral Tradition; Genre and Concepts of History; Myth and Reality; The Christianisation of Denmark and Eastern Scandinavia; The Use of Sagas and Eddas in the 21st Century; and Open Session.

Deadline for e-mailing abstracts: the 1st of November 2011 *The deadline is postponed to the 8th of November.*
